

### Mile High Culture Pass – 4-Day Pass

### What is it:

The pass is a printable "ticket" to be used for multiple days at multiple attractions. The 4-Day Pass was developed specifically for international travel companies to purchase the pass and/or offer it to their customers. VISIT DENVER is piloting the program with one price/adult price ticket only. Omniticket is the ticketing company that will handle all the set up, purchase software, payment, etc.

### Pricing:

• Four attractions for four days at \$34 net with a set mark-up and maximum consumer price of \$40. This represents a savings of more than \$15.

- The pass is activated at the first attraction visited.
- Purchasers may only visit each attraction once.
